### TRACES DU SANGLIER 2019

IN THE FOOTSTEPS OF THE WILDBOAR

**Vintage :** 2019

**Name of Protected Region of Origin :** Bergerac Rouge

**Description of Soil and Parcel of Vines :** One parcel of Merlot vines planted in 2015 and one parcel of Merlot vines planted in 2007, both on a gentle south-facing slope of limestone and clay.

**Varietal :** Merlot 94% and Cabernet Sauvignon 6%

**Yield per hectare :** 47 hl

**Tasting Notes :** Normally, we add the juice from this particular young parcel into our regular Bergerac Rouge, but this year the fruit was so abundant and promising that we decided to leave it to ferment on its own and see what came of it. Are we glad we did! The resulting wine from this particular plot of vines won a gold medal in Bordeaux and earned the right to have its own name. It is dark and rich and everything you could ask for in a powerful and smooth red full of blackberry and fig jam. The tannins are already beginning to mature and the result is a delightful mouthfeel and a lingering sensation of warm, spicy goodness.

**Method of Fabrication :** Alcoholic fermentation in temperature controlled stainless steel vats for one week at 25C. Cold pre-fermentation maceration, followed by 10 additional days in full vats. Malolactic fermentation after pressing in stainless at 20C.

**Aging :** In full 97hl stainless steel vats

**Ecological Method :** Made without herbicides or man-made pesticides. All weeding between the vines is mechanical. The organic system of sexual confusion is used to combat grapevine moth.

**Harvest :** Mechanical

**Alcohol by Volume :** 15,6 %

**Date of Bottling :** 23.07.2021

**Number of Bottles Produced :** 12.125



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
